3) **1 Samuel 20** "And ( Jonathan ) made David swear again by his love for him, for he loved him as he loved his ( own soul )."

4) **1 Samuel 21** Whose sword did David receive from Ahimelech the priest at Nob? **A: Goliath**

3) **1 Samuel 25** Who was the stubborn and wicked man who rejected the request of David's men and ignored David? **A: Nabal**

1) **1 Samuel 26** What two items near the head of Saul did David and Abishai take?

**A: Spear and Water Jar**

2) **1 Samuel 27** How long did David stay with the Philistines as a servant of Achish, king of Gat?

**A: 1 year and 4 months**

3) **1 Samuel 28** Who did Saul ask the medium to bring out? **A: Samuel**

#### 4. WEDNESDAY (3/22)

- 1) **1 Samuel 29** David was in a predicament of having to join Achish in war against Israel. What allowed David to return and not participate in the war against Israel? **A: The Philistine princes did not trust David.**
- 2) **1 Samuel 30** How many men did David lead in fighting the Amalekites? **A: 400**
- 3) **1 Samuel 31** Who took the dead bodies of Saul and his three sons, buried them, and fasted for seven days? **A: inhabitants of Jabesh-gilead**
